Proton wins 2 awards

THREE companies in the automotive industry were honoured at the 2010 Frost & Sullivan Malaysia Excellence Awards yesterday.

They were Proton Holdings Bhd, Perusahaan Otomobil Nasional Kedua Sdn Bhd and Ingress Corp Bhd.

Proton clinched two awards for the Best Passenger Car Model of the Year for Proton Saga and the Best Automotive Debut Model of the Year for the Exora.

Other awards for different categories such as the Technology Innovation Award for Emerging Human Computer Interface Technologies went to Smart Surface Sdn Bhd and the Technology Innovation Award for Methane Extraction in Biogas System went to Navaviro Technology

Sdn Bhd.

Meanwhile, the Green Builder of the Year award went to Sime Darby Property Bhd, the Best Oil and Gas Service Provider of the Year to Bumi Armada Bhd and the Best Logistics Service Provider of the Year to Poslaju.

Growth Leadership Award for Stem Cell Banking and Therapeutics went to StemLife Bhd and the Healthcare Services Provider of the Year went to Prince Court Medical Centre.

"There has been some remarkable performance by Malaysian companies during a time of what was otherwise a tough year for the global economy," Asia-Pacific managing director and partner for Frost & Sullivan, Manoj Menon, said in a statement.
